Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No. 59 dated 4.4.2015 under Sections 366, 354, 341, 506, 34/120 IPC registered at Police Station Division No. 4, Ludhiana on the basis of compromise deed dated 19.12.2016 (Annexure P-2).

As per allegations in the FIR, respondent No. 2 was coming back from her college, Dhiraj Kumar and others threatened her and took her to unknown place. Dhiraj Kumar did vulgar activities with her forcibly. On this background, FIR was got registered. During the pendency of petition, the matter has been duly compromised.

In compliance of order dated 20.2.2017, report dated 22.3.2017 of District And Sessions Judge, Ludhiana has been received in this regard. As per report, statement of parties have been recorded. Complainant-respondent No.2

stated that the matter stands compromised between the parties and she does

not want to proceed further against the accused and has no objection, if the present F.I.R be quashed against the petitioners. The compromise has been entered voluntarily. To the same effect is the statements given by petitioners.

Consequently, in view of the status report dated 22.3.2017 and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Dr. Arvind Barsaul etc. versus State of Madhya Pradesh and another 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 910***, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No. 59 dated 4.4.2015 under Sections 366, 354, 341, 506, 34/120 IPC registered at Police Station Division No. 4, Ludhiana is quashed along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
