The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.113 dated 29.11.2015, under Sections 304 and 279 of IPC, registered at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, District Rupnagar.

As per prosecution version, the present petitioner was driving a Tipper truck and which had struck against a Tempo Tata Ace vehicle and in such occurrence, five lives were lost.

Dalbara Singh complainant as also Dara Singh who were both cited to be eye-witness to the occurrence are yet to be examined before the trial Court. They would be seen as material prosecution witnesses.

While declining the prayer for bail made by the petitioner at this stage and disposing of the instant petition, liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the Court afresh seeking benefit of bail after the deposition of Dalbara Singh and Dara Singh is concluded.

Disposed of.

In the meanwhile, prosecution would make every endeavour to have the complainant as also eye-witness Dara Singh examined before the trial Court at an early date.
