The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C seeking concession of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.11 dated 17.1.2015 sections 304, 328 I.P.C and sections 3, 4, 5 of Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act, 1956, registered at Police Station, Phase 11, District S.A.S. Nagar, Mohali.

Counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that he would not be pressing the instant petition for the main relief of grant of regular bail but prays for indulgence of this Court for issuance of directions to expedite the trial.

As per prayer made by counsel, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

However, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has faced incarceration since 17.1.2015 and the charges were framed as far back as on 10.5.2015, Trial Court is directed to make an endeavor to expedite the trial proceedings.
