With the joint efforts of counsel for the parties, the parties have been able to arrive at a settlement.

The petitioners and husband of the complainant have agreed to pay an amount of Rs. 7.5 lakhs to the complainant towards her claim of permanent alimony, maintenance, dowry articles etc. as full and final settlement. The complainant and Anshuman Singh shall file a joint petition for divorce under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 at Faridabad by the first week of July 2017. Payment of an amount of Rs. 7.5 lakhs shall be made in two instalments at the time of recording of statements in first motion and second motion in those proceedings.

Counsel for the petitioners would state that the present petition may be disposed of but without prejudice to rights of the petitioners to file a petition for quashing of proceedings on the basis of compromise, to be reduced in writing.

Till first week of July 2017, interim order passed in the present proceedings shall remain in force.

Disposed of accordingly.
