This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0965 dated 22.10.2016, under Sections 354-A/452/506/34 IPC and Section 12 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012, registered at Police Station, City Hisar, District Hisar, Haryana.

The petitioner is in custody since 15.11.2016.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Om Parkash, has informed that after presentation of challan, charges have been framed on 20.01.2017 and 10 prosecution witnesses are yet to be examined.

It is not being disputed that another FIR No.0966 dated 22.10.2016, under Sections 323/324/34 IPC has been registered at Police Station, City Hisar against the complainant's family on the basis of statement made by present petitioner as he also suffered injuries in the same

incident and during investigation, Section 307 IPC has been added in that

FIR. Petitioner also remained admitted in the hospital. Learned State counsel further informed that investigation in the said case is still going on.

Heard.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner and the fact that trial may take some time for its conclusion, this Court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on regular bail on furnishing of bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hisar.
