The petitioner is stated to have been in custody since 24.02.2016, upon 60 kgs. of poppy husk allegedly recovered from him. It is admitted that out of 9 witnesses, only 1 has been examined so far.

Obviously the trial is not likely to be concluded in the near future. Thus, with the petitioner having already been in custody for 8 ½ months and the quantity of poppy husk stated to have been seized only marginally above the commercial quantity, I consider it appropriate to admit the petitioner to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
