INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Akash has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.118 dated 05.12.2016, registered at Police Station Lambra, Jalandhar, under Sections 452, 324, 148 and 149 IPC and Section 307 IPC added later on.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the present petitioner has been named in the FIR. He has been stated to be armed with *datar* and caused injury on the vital part of body i.e. head of complainant and the said injury has been declared dangerous to life.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the facts that the petitioner is required for custodial

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interrogation and weapon is yet to be recovered, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
