Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the husband of the petitioner was also declared to be a proclaimed person in the proceedings under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act. An FIR under Section 174-A IPC was also registered against him. The husband of the petitioner appeared in the trial Court on 24.01.2017 and was granted regular bail in the proceedings under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act. On the said premise, anticipatory bail in CRM-M No.5592 of 2017 has been granted to the husband of the petitioner vide order dated 18.04.2017 by this Court.

Learned counsel submits that the petitioner has also appeared before the trial Court in the proceedings under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act and she has been granted regular bail by the Judicial Magistrate First Class,

Jagadhri vide order dated 24.01.2017. On the aforesaid premise, the case of the petitioner is at *par* with the case of her husband, who has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court.

This fact has not been disputed by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satnam Singh.

In view of above, since the petitioner has already appeared before the trial Court and has been granted regular bail, I deem it appropriate to grant concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. However, in FIR under Section 174-A IPC, the petitioner shall keep on appearing before the Investigating Officer as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions incorporated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
