INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Madhumita Adhikary has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.174 dated 06.05.2014, registered at Police Station Sadar Sonapat, under Sections 406, 420, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that the petitioner absented from the court proceedings on 10.04.2015 and ultimately she was declared proclaimed offender, as argued. No satisfactory explanation for absence from the court proceedings has been given by the petitioner. Otherwise also, application for anticipatory bail, moved by the petitioner before the Court of

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Session, was dismissed on 15.07.2016 and now the petition for anticipatory bail before this Court has been filed in the month of February, 2017.

Keeping in view the facts that the petitioner has already misused the concession of bail already granted to her; she has avoided the process of court and has already been declared proclaimed offender, I find that no ground is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, finding no merit in this petition, the same is dismissed.
