SURINDER GUPTA, J.(Oral)

Written statement filed on behalf of respondents No.4 and 5
in Court today is taken on record.

Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.4 and 5
submits that he has instructions to submit on behalf of respondents No.4
and 5 that they will not interfere in the matrimonial life of the petitioners.
In fact, Sunil Chanana petitioner No.1 who is son of respondents No.4
and 5 has entered into third marriage with Jyoti Chanana petitioner No.2.
However, he will face the consequences of the same. He further submits
that the police at the behest of the petitioners is intentionally harassing
respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Raghbir
Singh submits that the police has initiated the action in this case and

challaned respondents No.4 and 5 under Sections 107, 150 Cr.P.C.. Respondents No.4 and 5 are not being called to the police station any more. The above step was taken only to ensure the security and safety of the petitioners who have now refused to take any police security. Learned counsel for the petitioner endorses submission by learned State counsel.

In view of the above submission of the learned counsel for respondents No.4 and 5, learned State counsel and learned counsel for the petitioners, this petition is disposed of as no further direction to police is required. However, the petitioners, if apprehend any danger to their life and liberty, may file application before respondent No.2, who will take appropriate action on it in accordance with law.

However, it is made clear that this order will have no effect on the validity of alleged marriage of the petitioners or on any other civil or criminal proceedings instituted against them.
