By filing the present petition, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.180 dated 30.09.2016, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Model Town, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

It is contended that the petitioner is ready and willing to settle the matter.

The learned counsel for the complainant, on instructions states that at this stage, the complainant is not open to any conciliation proceedings.

The learned State counsel opposes the bail application and state that the petitioner is a habitual offender and he is involved in other 05 FIRs.

Heard.

This is the 2nd bail petition filed on behalf of the petitioner. The first bail application was dismissed by passing a detailed order, by way of order dated 18.11.2016 (Annexure P-6). The learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to point out any fresh favorable circumstance in favour of the petitioner. Keeping in view the above, this Court is not inclined to accept the prayer made in the instant petition.

Dismissed.
