Petitioner has assailed order dated 01.09.2012 passed by Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Tohana whereby he has been declared as proclaimed person.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner was arrayed as accused No.49 in the complaint case under Sections 323, 324, 427, 452, 295-A, 506, 148, 149 IPC and was declared as proclaimed person vide order dated 01.09.2012. Co-accused faced the trial and were acquitted for the offences under Section 324 IPC read with Section 149 IPC but convicted for the offences under Section 148, 452, 323 IPC read with Section 149 IPC and were accordingly granted benefit of probation by the trial Court vide order dated 20.11.2014.

Learned counsel further contended that the petitioner is

ready and willing to appear before the trial Court.

In view of above, this petition is disposed of with a direction that in the event of appearance of the petitioner and filing of a petition for regular bail, the same shall be decided within a period of seven days by the trial Court in accordance with law.
