RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J.(ORAL)

Petitioner claimed that he won Literacy award for his book in USA in the year 2012 and was also appointed as Consulate General by Government of United Kingdom. As on date, he is working as Editor-in-Chief of newspaper namely "Link Pardesi" and he is also running electronic media/channel in Jalandhar.

By referring to dispute of civil nature between him and his brother-in-law and sister, petitioner pointed out that respondents No.5 and 6 along with one Amarjit Singh have committed fraud with the petitioner. Precisely for the grievance made by the petitioner, a representation dated 27.09.2016 (Annexure P1) is statedly pending before respondent No.3 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner.

At this stage, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, this petition can be disposed of by directing

respondent No.3 to have a fair look on the representation and pass appropriate order in accordance with law. Respondent No.3 would be at liberty to associate petitioner as well as any other person, if so required.
