The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No. 192, dated 30.04.2016, under Sections 420, 323, 506, 34, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-17, Chandigarh, on the basis of compromise dated 23.05.2016 (Annexure P-2), which has been arrived at between the parties.

A coordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 21.02.2017 had directed the parties to appear before the trial Court/Illaqu Magistrate to record the statements of the parties with regard to genuineness of the compromise and send a report to this Court. The report of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Chandigarh, dated 16.03.2017, has been received, wherein it is stated that in pursuance to the order of this Court, the statements of the parties were recorded, which indicates that they have entered into compromise at their own accord and without any coercion and undue influence.

The FIR is offshoot of a dispute for payment of ₹80,000/-, which has now been resolved with the intervention of the respectable. The matter has been voluntarily compromised between the parties and in view the mandate of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of ***Narinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another, (2014) 6 SCC 466***, it would be in the interest of justice if the proceedings are quashed to put quietus to the litigation between the parties.

Therefore, the petition is allowed and FIR No. 192, dated 30.04.2016, under Sections 420, 323, 506, 34, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector-17, Chandigarh and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
