The petitioner prays for grant of bail in anticipation of arrest in FIR No.79 dated 17.08.2011 registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar for offence punishable under Sections 494 and 498-A of the Indian Penal Code (in short 'IPC').

After arguing for some time, counsel for the petitioner states that the petition may be disposed of but with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Magistrate. However, it has been prayed that some directions may be issued to the Court below for disposal of her application for grant of regular bail in a time bound manner.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of. The petitioner shall surrender before the trial Magistrate within a period of 07 days and her application for bail, if any, filed before the Court shall be disposed of within a period of 05 days from the date of its filing.
