On 07.03.2017, following order was passed.

*“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is ready to pay the remaining amount of Rs.1 lac to the complainant.*

*In view of above, petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 17.03.2017 with the demand draft of Rs.1 lac to be drawn in the name of the complainant and the Investigating Officer would facilitate payment of the amount to the complainant.*

Though the petitioner has necessary explanation in the context of his appearing before the Investigating Officer and denial by Investigating Officer to accept the same.
