Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.35 dated 05.04.2013, registered under Sections 21/61/85 of NDPS Act at Police Station Jamalpur, District Ludhiana.

Petitioner was involved in a case under Section 21 of the NDPS Act and he was released on bail by the trial Court. Thereafter, he did not appear and was declared as Proclaimed Offender by the trial Court vide order dated 3rd July, 2014. Petitioner was arrested thereafter.

Learned State counsel on instructions from H.C. Raj Kumar submits that the prosecution evidence is almost complete. Only one prosecution witness is remained to be examined.

In view of aforesaid, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition at this stage. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner that in case trial is not concluded within a period of two months from today, he can file an application for grant of regular bail.
