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DEEPAK SIBAL, J.(ORAL)

Through the present petition Bhavleen Thiara and Sharanjeet Singh seek protection of their life and liberty which they apprehend to be in danger at the hands of respondents No.4 to 8 on account of the fact that they got married against their wishes.

Through order of this Court dated 21.02.2017, notice of motion was issued and in the meanwhile the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur (respondent No.2) was directed to forthwith consider the representation made to him by the petitioners and take appropriate action on the same, in accordance with law, to ensure the protection of their life and liberty.

Today Mr. Arpan Jyot Singh, Advocate has appeared on behalf of petitioner No.1 and he, on instructions from petitioner No.1, who is also present in Court, states that she admittedly being a major has opted to live with respondents No.4 to 8 and not with petitioner No.2.

In view of the afore referred statement, learned counsel for petitioner No.2 does not press the present petition. He however, seeks liberty to avail of his remedies which he may have in accordance with law on account of the alleged marriage which is said to have been solemnized between the petitioners.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case the present petition is dismissed with liberty to petitioner No.2 to avail of any alternate remedy that he may have in accordance with law.

It may be noted that the passport of petitioner No.1 which petitioner No.2 had with him has been returned to petitioner No.1 in Court.
