FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

Since both these two anticipatory bail applications have arisen out of the same very FIR, thus, are being disposed off together.

The allegations against the petitioners in these anticipatory bail applications under Section 438 Cr.P.C are that in pursuance of order of Civil Court, whereby, Police personnel went to village Chirwi to get possession of land and when the Police officials reached at site, a group of persons attacked them with bricks leading to simple injuries

to one of the constable Darbaj Singh.

The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioners that no specific role is attributed to the petitioners and that nothing is to be recovered from them.

In view thereof and keeping in view the fact that culpability if any shall be determined at the time of trial both the applications stand allowed. In the event of arrest of the petitioners, they be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer/Investigating Officer and that they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
