This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.186 dated 25.12.2016 registered under Section 323, 304 & 506 IPC at Police Station Morinda, District Rupnagar.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

The petitioner was granted interim bail by this court vide order dated 22.02.2017. It is not in dispute that the complainant has died after four days of the incident and the medical report says that it was heart attack.

Pursuant to order dated 22.02.2017 the learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and there is no other case reported against the petitioner.

In that view of the matter interim order dated 22.02.2017 is made absolute.
