Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to the respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of private respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are major and have solemnized their marriage in accordance with law. However, respondent No.4 is not accepting their marriage and is adamant to separate them from each other by resorting to illegal means. Learned counsel further submits that in view of imminent danger to the life and liberty of the petitioners, they had moved a representation dated 19.02.2017 (Annexure P-4) to the respondent No.2 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar.

In compliance of the order dated February 22, 2017 of this Court, the status report by way of affidavit of Satinder Kumar, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Central, Jalandhar has already been filed.

Heard.

Without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to take appropriate remedial measures, as warranted by law, on the representation dated 19.02.2017 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioners.
