By this petition, FIR No.98 dated 14.07.2014, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 452, 324, 34 IPC, is sought to be quashed, on the basis of a compromise arrived at between the petitioners-accused and respondent no. 2, i.e. the complainant.

Vide an order of this Court dated 07.04.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the learned Area Magistrate to get their statements recorded, in terms of the compromise.

Pursuant to the said order, the report of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala, has been received, stating therein that the statements of respondent no.2, i.e. complainant Varun Kumar Sharma, as also of the petitioners, Raj Kumar and Inder Kumar, have been recorded

which according to the assessment of that Court is voluntary and without any pressure.

In view of the fact that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and the offences involved are not such as can be termed as heinous offences, this petition is allowed and FIR no.98 dated 14.07.2014, registered against the petitioners at Police Station Sadar Kapurthala, District Kapurthala, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 452, 324, 34 IPC, along with all proceedings arising therefrom, is hereby quashed.
