FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The allegations against the petitioner in this regular bail application under Section 439 Cr.P.C are that on 4.11.2016 the petitioner along with eight other persons had entered the shop of the complainant victim/Jatin Kumar and assaulted him and in the process alleged to have taken away articles including some money.

The contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the similarly placed co-accused Gurdit Singh @ Baba @ Gagandeep Singh has been allowed similar relief vide orders dated 13.02.2017 of this Court and that the case of the petitioner is not distinguishable that of the co-accused and that the trial is not likely to be concluded in near future.

Appreciating the submissions. It is duly accepted by the learned State counsel that both the parties are known to each other and on

account of certain business rivalry/dispute over money had led to this occurrence and that the culpability, if any, shall be determined at the time of trial, together with the principle of parity, the present application for grant of regular bail is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
