Petitioner-L.S.Yadav has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.37 dated 11.01.2017, registered at Police Station Model Town, Rewari, under Sections 181, 200 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR has been registered against the petitioner-allottee who has availed illegal benefit of more than one residential plot in Urban Estates in Haryana under reserved category.

In pursuance of the interim order dated 23.02.2017, the petitioner has already joined the investigation. He is now not required for custodial interrogation. The case is based on documentary evidence. Moreover, accused in another case in the similar circumstances has also been granted anticipatory bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I find merit in this petition and the same is allowed. The interim order dated 23.02.2017 passed by this Court, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
