Learned counsel for the respondents has placed on file the short reply by way of affidavit of Vijay Prabha, Principal, Govt. Sr. Secondary School, Loharu, Bhiwani on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. The same is taken on record. It shows that a sum of ₹57,290/- as per the Government rates has been deposited in the account of petitioner on account of medical reimbursement. The present petition has been filed in the year 2008 regarding the medical bills pertaining to the year 2007.

Since the payments have been made late, therefore, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that the respondents shall also pay interest @ 9% per annum on the delayed payment starting three months from the date of submission of the medical bills till the date of payment.
