The petitioner was released on bail during trial. However, she remained absent on 13.10.2016 during the trial. The reason given by the petitioner is that she was suffering from high fever with headache and even she could not inform her lawyer in this regard. The trial Court has disbelieved the reason.

I do not find any fault in the impugned order. However, in view of the fact that the petitioner is already granted bail, by way of last chance, the petitioner can be granted bail pending trial.

In that view of the matter, I make the following order:

(i) CRL. MISC. No.M-6061 OF 2017 is allowed.

(ii) Petitioner shall be released on bail on furnishing fresh bail bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
