Through the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr. P. C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.1, dated 19.01.2017, registered under Sections 379 and 411 IPC, at Police Station Cantt Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Seeking anticipatory bail for the petitioner, learned counsel submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case; the petitioner has not purchased the stolen articles as alleged and that in terms of the interim order of this Court dated 23.02.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation and has fully cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Baldev Singh admits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer needed for further questioning.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and order dated 23.02.2017 granting ad-interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made

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absolute subject to the conditions as prescribed under Section 438(2)
Cr. P. C.

Nothing observed herein above shall be considered to be an
expression of opinion by this court on the merits of the case.

If the petitioner is found indulging in any other criminal act or
misusing the concession of bail granted by this Court, it would be open to
the State to seek cancellation of bail granted through this order by filing an
appropriate application before the competent Court/this Court.
