Counsel for the parties are ad idem that dispute between the petitioner and complainant has been settled by way of compromise arrived at in the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and a report in this regard has also been received from the Mediation Centre containing settlement agreement dated 20.4.2017.

In view of the above, interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 21.3.2016 is made absolute subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) He shall join the investigation as and when required by the Investigating Officer.
- (ii) He shall not offer any threat, promise or inducement to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing the same to the Investigating Officer/Court; and
- (iii) He shall not leave the limits of this country without prior permission of the Court.

Parties shall remain bound by the settlement.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
