Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.428 dated 25.11.2016 registered under Sections 21/61/85 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Civil Line Kaithal, District Kaithal.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI, Baljeet Singh states that petitioner is also involved in number of cases. The aforesaid contention has been refuted by learned counsel for the petitioner by asserting that petitioner has not been convicted in any of the case and he is on bail in other cases. The alleged recovery in the present case is 9.50 grams smack, which is non-commercial quantity.

Petitioner is in custody since 25.11.2016. Challan has already been presented and 02.03.2017 is the date fixed for framing of charges before the trial Court.

At this stage, without commenting anything upon merits of

the case, petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing heavy bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
