Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from being invaded at the hands of respondents No.3 and 4 who are police officers. The allegations have been made that the petitioner did not oblige respondents No.3 and 4 and as a result of that, he has earned unnecessary wrath of these respondents in the form of lodging of FIR No.9 dated 09.01.2017 under Section 188 IPC, Police Station City Khanna, District Khanna against him. Petitioner apprehends foul play for which he seeks the aforesaid relief.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Shilesh Gupta, Addl, AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes of pass, there is no requirement of calling upon reply as no order

prejudicial to the interest of the parties is being passed.

At this stage, this petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to have a fair look on the grievance of the petitioner in view of his representation dated 16.01.2017 without being swayed away by any observation made by this Court. For ascertaining the *bona fide* of the petitioner, respondent No.2 would be at liberty to devise his/her own mechanism to collect material and then pass necessary orders in accordance with law.
