The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in complaint No.62 dated 21.02.2015, under Sections 406/494/498-A IPC read with Section 34/120-B IPC.

Pleadings on record would clearly indicate that the petitioners had first in point of time approached the Court below seeking interim protection but the same was dismissed as not pressed in the light of order dated 17.12.2016 (Annexure P-2). Thereafter, petitioners filed CRM No.M-46588 of 2016 before this Court and that was also dismissed as withdrawn on the prayer made by counsel on 27.12.2016. It transpires that the petitioners took the third chance before the Court of sessions and the same was also permitted to be withdrawn as per prayer made by counsel in the light of order dated 18.01.2017.

By filing the instant petition, the petitioners are taking yet another chance for claiming the concession of pre-arrest bail. The conduct of the petitioners does not inspire confidence.

Petition is dismissed.
