Petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR

No.84 dated 23.08.2014 under Sections 302, 307, 323, 148, 149

IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Phagwara.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Kunal Malhotra. The case against the petitioner was that the friend of the complainant namely Rohit Sabharwal was murdered by one Rohit Sharma in a quarrel which took place in a restaurant.

The role attributed to the petitioner was that he was accompanying other accused persons and gave injuries on the person of the complainant. No specific role was attributed in the context of giving any specific injury to the complainant or the deceased.

On a pointed query, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Pargat Singh admitted that the case of the petitioner cannot be segregated from that of Vinay Sharma who has already been granted regular bail by this Court in CRM-M No.33037 of 2015 on 08.07.2016.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon merits of the case and keeping in view the period of custody, it would be just and appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

In view of above, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an opinion on merits of the case.
