By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No.372 dated 17.07.2016, registered under Sections 5/13 (2) and 17 of Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan & Gausamvardhan Act, 2015, Section 11 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 and Sections 279 and 336 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Nuh, District Mewat.

On 02.03.2017, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel contends that the petitioner was not arrested from the spot and he is not involved in any other FIR.

Notice of motion for 27.04.2017.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

1.That he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;

2.That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police

*officer and;
3. That he shall not leave India without prior
permission of the Court”*

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 02.03.2017 the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 02.03.2017, is made absolute, subject to furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

The petition stands allowed.
