The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.201 dated 11.10.2015, under Sections 22/61/85 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

As per prosecution version, an alleged recovery of 260 grams of intoxicant powder was effected from the petitioner.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner would concede that the report of the Chemical Examiner has since been received and the same was found to be containing Diphenoxylate Hydrochloride.

The alleged recovery from the petitioner would be construed as commercial.

Under such circumstances, this Court would not be inclined to accept the prayer of the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail.

Petition dismissed.
