As already noticed in the order dated 17.04.2017, despite notice having been ordered to be issued on 23.02.2017, it actually could not be issued as process fee has not been deposited by learned counsel for the petitioners thereafter.

The petitioners are seeking protection of their lives and liberty in this petition, apprehending such threat at the hands of respondents no.4 to 8, the petitioners having married each other against the will of the aforesaid respondents, as contended in the petition.

Consequently, when none is pursuing the petition, it is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous, but with a

direction to respondents no.2 and 3, to ensure that the lives and liberty of the petitioners is duly protected, within the four corners of law.

It is further clarified that if any of the averments made in this petition are found to be incorrect, no order passed in this petition shall be construed to be a bar on any legal proceeding validly initiated by a competent person.
