INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner-Mintu @ Mau has filed this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.190 dated 20.11.2016, registered at Police Station Division No.5, Jalandhar, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 326, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that as per the prosecution version, the petitioner has been named in the FIR. He has been stated to be armed with *datar* and gave injury on the right side of head of the complainant. The co-accused have also caused injuries to the complainant as well as other injured.

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Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and nature and gravity of the offence and in view of the fact that weapon is yet to be recovered, I do not find it a fit case where the petitioner is entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
