Petitioner seeks regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.424 dated 26.09.2016, under Sections 395/341/379 B of IPC, registered at Police Station Ganaur, District Sonapat, Haryana.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Didar Singh. Allegations are that a Canter vehicle which was transporting goods belonging to Blue Dart Courier Company was intercepted while proceeding from Samalkha to Ludhiana by occupants of one Wagon-R car and had been taken away after tying down the driver as also the cleaner of the vehicle.

During the course of investigation, Bijender Kumar, Jai Kumar and Hemant who had been arrested in some other case were implicated in the present case as well on the basis of their disclosure statements.

The name of the present petitioner has figured in the disclosure statement of the aforenoticed three co-accused.

The petitioner was arrested on 17.10.2016.

Investigation in the case is complete, challan stands presented and even charges have been framed. Trial is at the very initial stage.

As per prosecution, the recovery effected from the present petitioner is of two mobile phones and one black coloured jean.

Without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail. Petition is allowed.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sonapat.
