The prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.67 dated 08.08.2016 for the offence under Sections 376, 452, 506 IPC and under Section 3(I)(xii) of the SC and ST (Prevention of Atrocities Act, 1989), registered at Women Police Station, Yamuna Nagar.

Petitioner is in custody since 24.08.2016.

As per allegations in the FIR that petitioner had trespassed the house of prosecutrix and committed rape upon her. At that time family members of the prosecutrix had gone to Karnal to see their relative who met with an accident. The brother of the prosecutrix in his statement under Section 161 Cr.P.C. has not stated anything with regard to said incident.

Learned counsel for the State has informed the Court on instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh that on 22.09.2016 challan has been presented and charges have been framed in this case on 24.10.2016. He further submits that the next date for prosecution evidences is fixed for 27.01.2017.

In view of the above and considering the fact that trial is not likely to conclude in near future, petitioner be released on regular bail on furnishing his fresh bail bonds/sureties to the satisfaction of Duty Magistrate/Illaq Magistrate, Yamuna Nagar.
