Present petition is for release of petitioner on regular bail in FIR No.108 dated 20.09.2016, under Sections 307, 498A and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Jaitu, District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present case the version of the complainant has been found false by the police and co-accused, namely, Makhan Singh, Paramjit Kaur and Jagjit Singh, have been found innocent and have been kept in Column No.2. Moreover, as per the medical report from Aafta Hospital at Dutt Road, Moga, the injuries caused to the complainant have been declared as simple in nature.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from investigating officer,

has informed that out of total 14 witnesses, none has been examined so far.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and with their able assistance gone through the material available on record.

The petitioner was arrested on 02.10.2016. Since then, he is in judicial custody and no useful purpose would be served to further detain him in jail. The final conclusion of trial will take a long time.

In view of above facts, the present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Judge/Duty Magistrate, Faridkot.

Needless to mention that, nothing observed here-in-above, would reflect, on merits in the trial of the main case, in any manner.
