Pursuant to the order dated 01.03.2017, the petitioner is stated to have joined investigation, but both learned State counsel and counsel for the complainant submit that the blank papers alleged to have been got signed from the complainant and his wife were actually got signed by the petitioner himself and therefore, simply because he is only an accountant working with M/s Ankit Aulaketch Private Limited run by one Lokesh Gupta, a co-accused, the petitioner cannot take the plea of being only an employee, therefore being innocent.

In the aforesaid circumstances, I see no reason to continue with the interim order dated 01.03.2017.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed and the interim order is hereby vacated.
