Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.242 dated 27.12.2016 registered under Sections 5/13(2) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act 2015 at Police Station Nagina, District Mewat.

On the basis of secret information, four cows were recovered who were found tied with the ropes with kikar trees. On seeing the police party, petitioner fled away from the spot. In order to ascertain the place from where the petitioner had brought the cows in question for the purposes of slaughtering, a custodial interrogation is required. Rubbing marks were found on cows which were going to be slaughtered.

In view of aforesaid, I do not see any justification for giving benefit of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
