The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in FIR No.191 dated 26.11.2016 registered under Sections 399,402 IPC and 25,27,54,59 of Arms Act at Police Station Sadar Jagraon, District Ludhiana.

Heard learned counsel for the rival parties.

Pursuant to the secret information, the FIR was registered and thereafter raid was conducted. According to the prosecution, the other persons as well as the petitioner were found rifles and, therefore, there is a reason to believe that the petitioner was also the person who had designed to commit robbery by use of the weapon.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Kuldeep Singh submits that there is no other case of similar type against the petitioner.

In that view of the matter, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner. Hence, I make the following order:

ORDER

- (i) The CRL.MISC. No.M-6407 of 2017 is allowed.
- (ii) The petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of concerned CJM/Duty Magistrate.
