Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage he would be satisfied if this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.2 to take a decision on the representation made by the petitioner to him on 02.12.2016, a copy of which has been annexed as Annexure P-1 with the petition, as per law.

The allegation is that the petitioner having married a non-Muslim woman, respondents no.4 and other members of the society that he is stated to belong to, are allegedly harassing the petitioner and his wife.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with directions to respondent No.2, i.e. the Inspector General of Police, Patiala Zone, to look into the matter and to take appropriate action on the aforesaid representation and to ensure that the lives and liberty of the petitioner and his family members are duly protected within the four corners of law.
