Present petition has been filed against the order passed by Sessions Judge, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar on 7.3.2015 whereby respondent was directed to be released on probation on furnishing bonds to the tune of ₹ 25,000/- each with surety in the like amount and undertaking to be of good behavior for a period of two years.

After perusing the facts on records, it has been found that benefit of probation has been rightly granted to respondent. He was 72years of age at the time of conviction. Respondent was directed to pay an amount of ₹ 1,00,000/- as cost of litigation/compensation payable to petitioner.

Learned counsel for respondent submits that amount of ₹ 1,00,000/- as cost of litigation/compensation has been deposited.

On 9.3.2017, both parties requested that matter be referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court to resolve the matter. Parties were directed to remain present before the Mediation Centre on 22.3.2017.

As per the report, case has been returned back by Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court with the report that *“parties have failed to settle their dispute amicably”*.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and going through the material available on record, I do not find any illegality or infirmity in the order passed by Sessions Judge, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar on 7.3.2015.

Dismissed.
