AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (Oral)

By this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail. Having earlier been granted anticipatory bail but thereafter not having appeared before the learned trial Court, his bail bonds were forfeited. As such, the petitioner cannot be allowed to jump bail before one Court and try to seek anticipatory bail before a higher Court.

Hence, I see no ground to grant the concession of anticipatory bail. The petition is consequently dismissed.

However, since the contention is that the petitioner remained absent for only one date, upon him surrendering before the trial Court and presenting an application for 'regular bail', it would be disposed of at the earliest, preferably within 4 days by that Court, on its own merits.
