TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J.

This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.162, dated 16.11.2016, under Sections 323/324/506/148/149 IPC (Section 307 IPC added subsequently), registered at Police Station Machhiwara, District Khanna.

While issuing notice of motion on 27.02.2017, the following order was passed by this Court.

“Counsel submits that the FIR came to be registered on the statement of Gurnam Singh in relation to an occurrence that allegedly took place on 15.11.2016. In such occurrence Manjeet Singh and Roshan Singh are alleged to have suffered grievous injuries. It is the contention of the counsel that in so far as the present petitioner is concerned and who is a lady, she was alleged to have been armed with a stick and had delivered blow on the head of the complainant Gurnam Singh. It is argued that no injury on the person of Manjeet Singh and Roshan Singh have been attributed to the present petitioner.

Notice of motion, returnable for 27.4.2017.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join investigation.

In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and she shall remain bound by the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Jagtar Singh apprises the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation and is not required for any custodial interrogation.

In the light of such stand taken on behalf of the State, prayer made in the instant petition is accepted. Order dated 27.02.2017 passed by this Court is made absolute.

Disposed of.
