Joint affidavit of respondents No.4 and 5 has been filed. Same is taken on record.

As per said affidavit, respondents No.4 and 5 have accepted the alleged marriage of the petitioners and submitted that neither they have harmed nor they will harm the petitioners.

Heard.

Without going into the validity of the marriage, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to the petitioners to contact respondents No.2 and 3, who, after their satisfaction that the petitioners are actually facing threat, shall take necessary steps to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from private respondents No.4 and 5, as per law.

However, it is made clear that this order, in no way, will affect any other proceedings pending or to be filed against the petitioners etc., which are to be dealt with independently as per law.
