Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Tanu Sharma in case registered by way of FIR No.226 dated 24.12.2016 at Police Station Division No.C, Amritsar under Section 420 IPC and Section 13 of the Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 28.02.2017 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sarabjit Singh from Police Station Division No.C, Amritsar who submits that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from her and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 28.02.2017 is made absolute on the same terms and conditions till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). However, she shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and thereafter, she will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
