This petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of 'anticipatory bail' to the petitioner in case FIR No. 158 dated 14.09.2013, registered at Police Station Division No. 2, Jalandhar, for the alleged commission of offences punishable under Sections 307, 336, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act.

The merits of the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner as regards the involvement of the petitioner in the aforesaid offences apart, it is seen that the petitioner has been declared to be a Proclaimed Offender in connection with the aforesaid FIR itself.

Consequently, this petition seeking anticipatory bail, cannot be entertained.

However, upon the petitioner appearing before the trial Court and making an appropriate application for 'regular bail', that would be decided by that court on its merits at the very earliest, preferably within a period of one week of the filing of the application.
