Petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No. 132 dated 01.04.2016 under Section 420/467/468/471/120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Kaithal.

The FIR was registered at the instance of Neetu wife of Rakesh Kumar on the allegations that she has purchased one plot from Krishan Kumar. The plot in question allegedly came to Krishan Kumar from Sumitra who in turn got it from Birmati.

Challan has already been presented. The petitioner is in judicial custody since 21.10.2016.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Ishwar Singh stated that no prosecution witness has been examined so

far and the trial is fixed for 01.04.2017.

In view of above, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an opinion on merits of the case.
